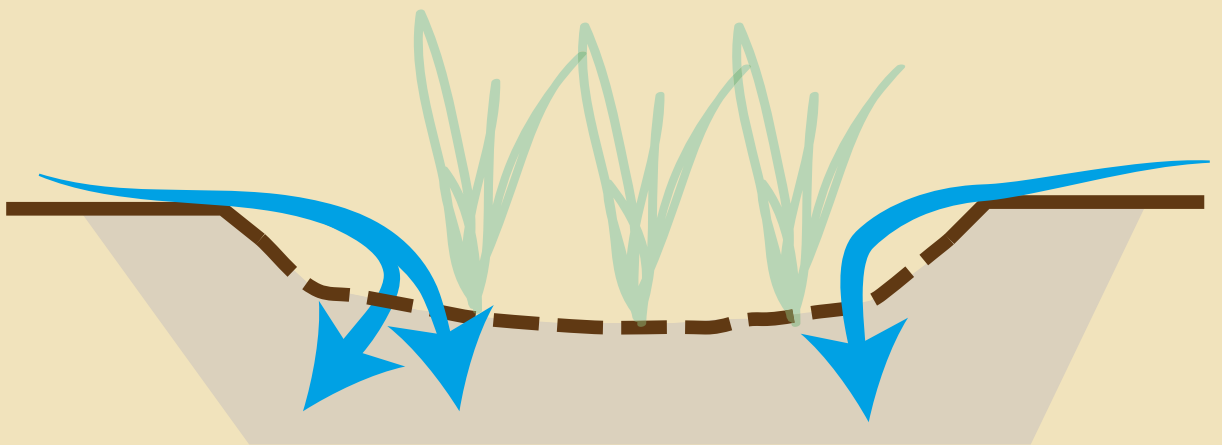

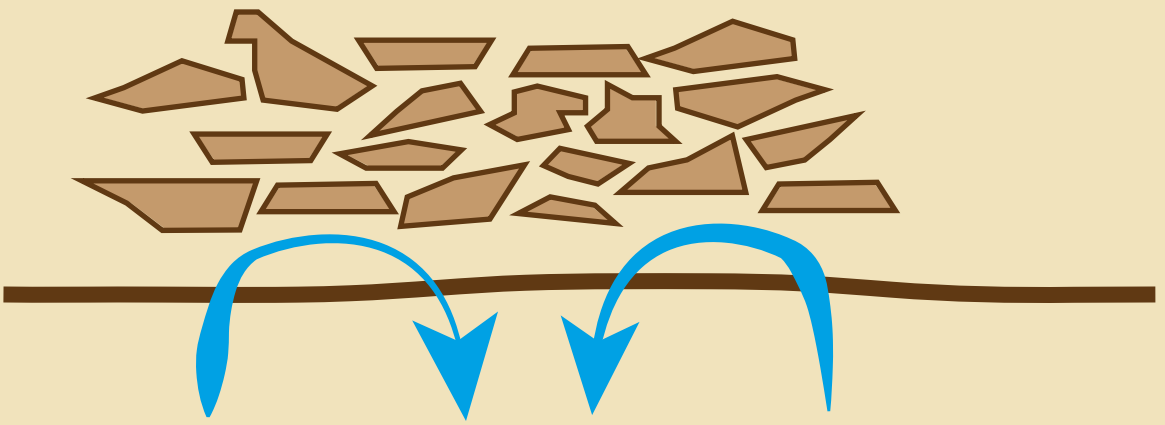
RAIN GARDEN

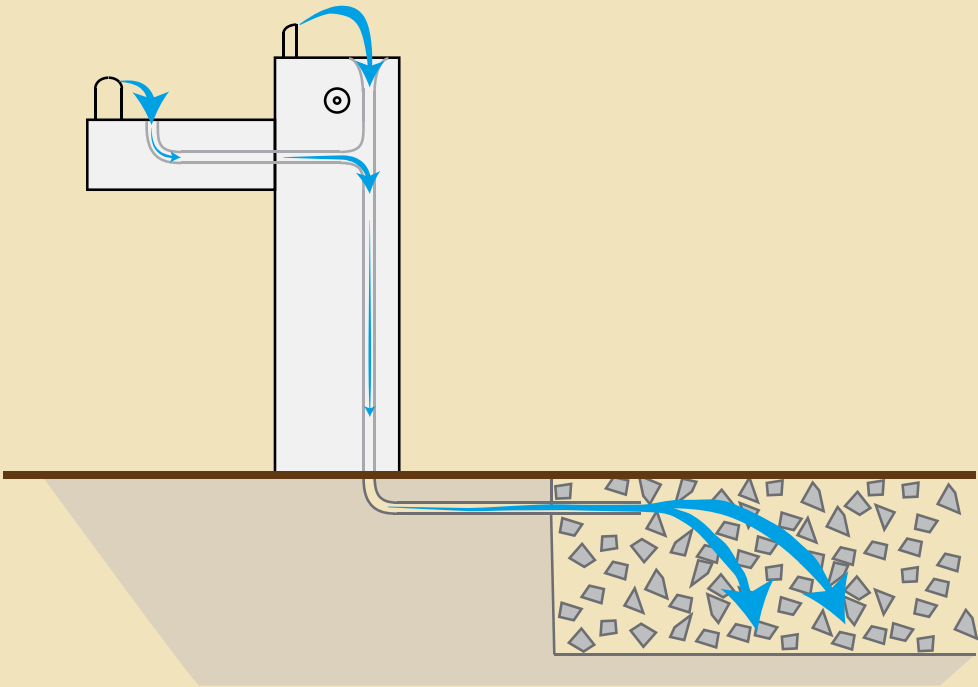


MULCHING

Placing a layer of leaves or arbor mulch around vegetation and over exposed soil prevents evaporation, reduces erosion and suppresses weeds.
